Robyn's story

All of the best things in Robyn's life happened at airports. When she was thirteen, her mom handed her a copy of <u>Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone</u> to read on a family vacation. By the time the plane landed, Robyn had finished the book, and decided to become a novelist.

She spent the next year saving up to buy a laptop, and scribbling her first novel in notebooks. In high school, she taught herself how to write books by attending a writing critique group at the local Barnes & Noble, and at eighteen, she sold her first novel to Random House.

But getting a book deal wasn't the happy ending to her story. Her debut novel flopped. As a junior at Barnard College of Columbia University, she panicked and switched her studies from English to Pre-Med.



But she never stopped writing. After chemistry lab, she'd sneak away to a coffee shop and write books. When she sold her first middle grade fantasy series, she deferred medical school and moved to London, England to write--only to have her editor and agent quit the business. Her series was shelved midway through.

While studying bioethics at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania, Robyn began to write the book that would become The Beginning of Everything--literally. That novel went on to sell in a six-figure auction in less than a week. Robyn wrapped up her medical studies, stopping at a masters degree, and moved to Los Angeles to write. She's been a full-time novelist ever since.

The Beginning of Everything has sold more than a quarter-million copies, and is published in a dozen languages worldwide. When the book was optioned for film, Robyn was hired to write the screenplay. She went on to write three more critically-acclaimed and award-winning contemporary young adult novels: Extraordinary Means, Invisible Ghosts, and You Don't Live Here.

Remember how the best things happened to her in airports? On her way to promote The Beginning of Everything at a conference, she met a boy traveling to the same event who wanted to know what book to read on an airplane. Reader, she married him.

But while she was publishing contemporary fiction, Robyn never let go of her love of fantasy stories, and decided to write one in secret. She sold her Emry Merlin series a few weeks into the pandemic, and is thrilled to finally get to tell the story of a brilliant female wizard. The first book in the series, The Other Merlin, will be published Sept. 21, 2021. The next book will be released in 2022.

Robyn lives in Los Angeles with her husband, their dog Penny, her collection of antique medical instruments, and far too many books. Next on her agenda? Emry Merlin book 3!
